Eytan Gilboa is Professor of Political Science and Communication and Founding Director of both the School of Communication and the Center for International Communication at Bar-llan University. He is a Senior Research Associate at the BESA Center for Strategic Studies and Visiting Professor of Public Diplomacy at USC. He received his MA and PhD degrees from Harvard University. Gilboa has published books and numerous articles on international communication and US policy in the Middle East. He contributes op-ed articles to newspapers and serves as a commentator on television and radio networks.
